I understand that many students have already attempted to access the Campus Climate Survey, but were unable to do so. Due to a string of unanticipated technical problems the survey was unavailable at various times over the past couple of weeks. This was a frustrating experience for everyone, but Institutional Research and Planning (the office responsible for administering the survey) has been working closely with the Office of Information Technology to get it all resolved. If you were one of the many people who tried but were unable to participate in the survey, we appreciate your patience, and hope you will try again.

We need as much input as possible when making decisions that affect our campus community. Recent events at NC State and other campuses around the country emphasize how important it is to systematically gather and report on information related to the campus climate. It will likely take about 25 minutes to complete the survey - - it is quite comprehensive. Because we administer the Campus Climate Survey only every five years we need to take this opportunity to collect a wide breadth of information.
