North Carolina State University 2018 Incoming Freshmen Survey: Open-Ended Comment Coding Scheme

The Incoming Freshmen Survey now includes two open-end questions, asking students 1) what they are most excited about in coming to NC State; and 2) what they are most concerned or nervous about in starting their first semester of college. Verbatim comments for each question were grouped into different categories by topic. (A single comment could be included in multiple categories.) The different categories for the Incoming Freshmen Survey open-ended comments are listed alphabetically below.

Independence (e.g., Making decisions on one's own, Freedom, Leaving home/family of origin) Most Excited Biggest Concerns

Instruction (e.g., Classes, Faculty/instructors) Most Excited Biggest Concerns

Learning (e.g., Education, Program of Study, Knowledge) Most Excited Biggest Concerns

Opportunities (e.g., academic, social, independence, new people) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Performance/Workload (e.g., Difficulty of coursework, Performing well/receiving good grades, Ability to keep up with course demands, Volume of coursework/homework) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Race/Ethnicity (e.g., Issues related to different ethnicities and cultures) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Registration (e.g., Getting into necessary courses, Enrolling in correct/enjoyable courses, Waitlisting) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Safety (e.g., Fear of crime, particularly theft, assault, and rape, General safety concerns, Fear of harassment) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Sexual Orientation (e.g., GLBT) Most Excited Biggest Concerns

Social Life (e.g., Making friends/establishing a social network, Meeting new people, Fitting in, Feeling lonely) Most Excited Biggest Concerns

Spirit (e.g., NC State pride, Tradition, Reputation) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Time Management (e.g., Meeting deadlines, Staying organized/focused, Balancing different demands, Autonomy to control one's time) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>

Transition to College (e.g., Adapting to college lifestyle, Experiencing new things/a "fresh start", Navigating campus, Finding classes, Leaving one's hometown) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u> **Transportation** (e.g., Busing, Parking, Getting around without a personal vehicle) <u>Most Excited</u> <u>Biggest Concerns</u>
