- On average, first-year students applied to 6 colleges for admission
- ¼ said "academic reputation" was the most influential factor in attending NC State
- 97% reported they were "very" or "moderately satisfied" with NC State's admission process



- 42% said their high school prepared them "very well" for college
- 49% said they prepared themselves "very well" for college



- 2/5 are from a rural/small town
- 19% are first generation college students
- 41% come from a family with combined income > \$100,000





Certainty of Academic Major, by College





Survey Methodology

The Incoming First-YearStudent Survey is administered every fall semester after incoming first-year students attend New Student Orientation. In 2022, of the 5,542 first-year students invited to participate in the survey; 3,008 students did so, for a response rate of 54%.
