

Applying to NC State

- On average, first-year students applied to 6 colleges for admission
- 61% said NC State was their "first" or "only" choice of colleges to attend
- 84% said NC State's academic reputation was a "strong" (49%) or "very strong" (35%) influence on their decision to attend


Certainty of Academic Major, by College



Background Characteristics

- 46% said their high school prepared them "very well" for college
- 49% said they prepared themselves "very well" for college
- 2/5 are from a rural/small town
- 9% are first generation college students
- 35% come from a family with combined income of \$100,000 or less
- 40% are taking out loans
- ³/₄ are using their own money to help with college expense
- 8% are using \$6,000 or more of their own money

Skill Development & Importance

When asked about 30 different skills, students gave high ratings to the importance, but relatively low ratings to their current development of:

- Time management
- Ability to manage ongoing stressors
- · Recovering from emotional setbacks
- Developing and sustaining an active and healthy lifestyle

45% said they will "probably" or "definitely" participate in a Study Abroad program

59% reported that they plan on pursuing a graduate or professional degree

21% intend to seek post-graduation employment only in North Carolina

The Incoming First-Year Student Survey is administered every fall semester after incoming first-year students attend New Student Orientation. In 2024, of the 5,718 first-year students invited to participate in the survey; 3,135 students did so, for a response rate of 54.8%.
