This report presents summary results from the December 2016 Future Plans Survey for departments in the College of Sciences, followed by summary information on employment and further education for the college as a whole.

Department Summaries

The following table provides summary statistics for December 2016 graduates in each of the College of Sciences departments. It includes the number of students in the department who graduated in December 2016 and the number of those students who submitted the Future Plans Survey.
