


The Job Search

- Of graduates starting new full-time employment:
 - \circ 52% received more than one job offer
 - o 36% received a signing bonus (median amount: \$6,250)
 - \circ 30% received a relocation package

Employment Characteristics

- 93% of those entering or continuing employment are full-time (vs. 7% part-time)
- Of those in full-time employment:
 - $_{\odot}$ Annual starting salary: \$65,635 (mean), \$68,750 (median)
 - \circ 68% are working in North Carolina
 - $_{\odot}$ 45% are working in the Triangle area (Raleigh, Durham, Chapel Hill)


Satisfaction with New Employment Position



Further Education

- Most respondents who are pursuing another degree are attending their first-choice school (88%)
- 77% are attending school in North Carolina
- 53% are attending NC State

Degree Seeking (N=383)



Career Preparation

- 65% participated in an internship while at NC State
- 59% used ePACK (NC State's online job and recruitment system)
- 59% attended a career fair while at NC State

- seniors
