

December 2024 Undergraduate Future Plans Survey – Fast Facts

Primary Plans after Graduation (N=534)



The Job Search (n=226)

- Of graduates starting new full-time employment:
 - 40% received more than one job offer
 - 19% received a signing bonus (median amount: \$6,250)
 - 12% received a relocation package

Employment Characteristics

- 90% of those beginning or continuing employment are full-time (vs. 10% part-time)
- Of those in full-time employment:
 - Average annual salary: \$66,653 (mean), \$71,250 (median)
 - 75% are working in North Carolina
 - 56% are working in the Triangle area (Raleigh, Durham, Chapel Hill)

Satisfaction with New Employment Position




Employers Hiring the Most Graduates



Further Education (N=142)

- 39% of those planning on graduate or professional school have been accepted and know where they will be going
 - 98% of those are attending their first choice school
 - 91% are attending school in North Carolina
 - 83% are attending NC State

Degree Seeking (N=53)



Career Preparation

- 60% participated in an internship while at NC State
- 61% used ePACK (NC State's online job and recruitment system)
- 60% attended a career fair while at NC State
