Combined Future Plans Surveys and Survey of Recent Graduates Academic Year 2014-2015 Graduates College of Education Summary Report

This summary report presents combined results from graduating seniors participating in either the December 2014 or May 2015 Future Plans Survey (FPS) or the follow-up September 2015 Survey of Recent Graduates (SRG) for the College of Education.

Department Summaries

The following table provides summary statistics for academic year 2014-2015 graduates in each of the College of Education departments. It includes the number of students in the department who graduated in December 2014, May 2015, or the first summer session of 2015 as well as the number of those students who submitted the Future Plans Survey and/or the Survey of Recent Graduates. It also includes the number of students who indicated that at the time of the survey they had already accepted a full-time position (including military and volunteer work [e.g., Peace Corps]), and the number who indicated they were either attending or planning on attending graduate or professional school. Finally, it includes summary statistics on the self-reported salaries of those having accepted full-time employment.
