

# Combined Future Plans Surveys and Survey of Recent Graduates: Academic Year 2019-2020 Baccalaureate Graduates Fast Facts



#### **About the Data**

- These data show the combined results of the semiannual Future Plans Surveys of Undergraduates and the Survey of Recent Graduates.
- 56% of graduating seniors (3250 out of 5545) from the 2019-2020 academic year completed the FPS/SRG.

- Two-thirds of graduates employed full-time obtained their position a month or more before graduation
- One in five graduates still seeking employment started their job search one month or less before graduation



- 90% of those starting a grad/prof degree are attending their first-choice school
- Half of those pursuing an advanced degree are enrolled at NC State



- The median salary of graduates employed full-time is \$53,750 (mean=\$52,840)
- One-fourth received an incentive such as a signing bonus or company shares



- 70% of those starting grad/prof school are enrolled in a master's degree program
- 15% are enrolled in a doctoral program
- 15% are enrolled in a professional program (e.g., medical school, law school)



- Graduates with full-time employment are working in 44 states and over 20 countries
- Half of those with full-time positions are working in the Research Triangle area (e.g., Raleigh, Durham, Chapel Hill)



## 90% or more graduates:

- are satisfied with their undergraduate program experience
- feel prepared for their future career path
