

Primary Plans after Graduation (n=2,425)




Further Education

Enrollment in Graduate/Professional School (n=725)

- Most respondents (91%) pursuing higher education are attending their first-choice school.
- Three-quarters (76%) are attending schools in North Carolina.
- Three-fifths (59%) are attending NC State.

Employment Characteristics (Full-Time Only)

The Job Search (n=1,060)

- 95% began looking for a job 3 or more months before graduation.
- 62% of respondents starting full-time employment reported receiving the job offer they accepted 3 or more months before graduation.

Compensation

- Mean salary: \$65,589
- Median salary: \$71,250
- Received signing bonus and/or company shares: 34.3%
- About half (54%) of those continuing in a job they had prior to graduation received a salary increase, promotion/ title change, or both.

Job Location

- Graduates are working in 41 states and 11 countries.
- 49% of those employed are working in the Triangle area (e.g., Raleigh, Durham, Chapel Hill).

- These data show the combined results of the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 Undergraduate Future Plans Surveys
- 41.8% of graduating seniors (2,425 out of 5,800) completed the combined FPS.

Satisfaction with Career Guidance from College/Department



Overall Experience

- 86% of all respondents said they are "very satisfied" (39%) or "satisfied" (47%) with their overall undergraduate program experience.
- 91% of graduates starting a full-time job after graduation reported being "very satisfied" (51%) or "satisfied" (40%) with their new position.
- Nearly all respondents (95%) feel "very excited" (60%) or "fairly excited" (35%) about their future paths.
