December 2019 Graduate Future Plans Survey Wilson College of Textiles Summary Report

This report presents summary results from the December 2019 Graduate Future Plans Survey for departments and types of degree programs in the Wilson College of Textiles, followed by summary information on employment and further education for the college as a whole.

Highlights for the Wilson College of Textiles

- 73% of the doctoral and master's students in WCOT graduating in fall 2019 responded to the survey
- 80% of doctoral respondents and 45% of master's respondents in WCOT report that they have secured full-time employment for the coming year
- WCOT graduates with full-time employment report an average salary in the coming year of \$86,111 (median = \$77,500)
- 44% of WCOT graduates with full-time employment will be working in North Carolina (33% in the Research Triangle Area)
- 27% of master's students in WCOT report that they plan to return to graduate/professional school in the coming year
- 100% of master's students in WCOT with definite plans to graduate/professional school will be attending a school in North Carolina

Department Summaries

The following tables provide summary statistics for December 2019 graduates in the Wilson College of Textiles. Table 1 includes the number of graduate students in the Wilson College of Textiles who graduated in December 2019 and the number of those students who submitted the Graduate Future Plans Survey. It also includes the number of students who indicated at the time of the survey that they would be working full-time, as well as the number of those who indicated they were either pursuing or planning to pursue another graduate or professional degree in the coming year. Finally, it includes summary statistics on the self-reported salaries of those who reported that they would be employed full-time. Table 2 and Table 3 provide the same summary statistics for December 2019 graduates in each department in the Wilson College of Textiles, for doctoral graduates and master's graduates, respectively.
