The Graduating Senior Survey includes two open-end questions asking students 1) "What is the most important thing that NC State could do to improve the quality of undergraduates' experience here?" ("suggestions") and 2) "Please share any general comments you have about your experiences at NC State or tell us why you were particularly satisfied or dissatisfied with any aspect of your education here" ("experiences"). Verbatim comments for each question were grouped into different categories by topic. A single comment could be included in multiple categories. The different categories for open-end comments are listed alphabetically below. If there is not hyperlink below, there were no comments in that category in response to that particular question.
