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2022 Sophomore Survey: Fast Facts



- 95% rate the learning environment on campus as "very strong" or "strong"
- 85% of respondents "strongly agree" or "agree" that NC State stimulated interest in an intended field of study
- 84% are confident that they made the right decision to attend NC State
- ⁴/₅ would still choose to attend NC State if starting over



Majorities of sophomores are "very satisfied" or "satisfied" with student services:

- Library services overall (85%)
- Informational technology overall (82%)
- Availability of academic assistance and tutoring programs (67%)




- ⁴/₅ are "very satisfied" or "satisfied" with how effectively instructors use technology in teaching/learning activities
- 7 in 10 are "very satisfied" or "satisfied" with academic advising services overall

Large majorities of sophomores report their college education has contributed "very much" or "somewhat" to their ability to:

- Effectively analyze and evaluate evidence, arguments, claims, beliefs (90%)
- Work effectively as part of a team (85%)
- Understand and respect diverse cultures, values, and perspectives (83%)
- Develop leadership skills (76%)

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- Nearly 8 in 10 report they "seldom" or "never" have concerns about personal safety on campus
- ³/₄ are "very satisfied" or "satisfied" with the availability of public information about crimes on campus

What Sophomore Students Say NC State is Doing Well





More than 50% say it is "somewhat" or "very likely" that they will participate in a Study Abroad program during their remaining time at NC State



94% report that they expect to be continually enrolled at NC State until graduation

Sophomore Survey Methodology

The Sophomore Survey is administered every three years in the spring semester to eligible sophomore students. Students who were enrolled as sophomores and had completed 45-59 credit hours by the beginning of the spring semester were eligible to complete the 2022 Sophomore Survey.

In 2022, 2,619 sophomore students were invited to participate in the survey; 686 students participated in the survey for a response rate of 26%.
