

2020 Incoming Transfer Student Survey: Fast Facts

90%

Reported NC State was their top choice college to continue their academic careers



- 47% are taking out loans
- 68% plan on working while in school
- 78% are using at least some of their own money to help with college expenses

84%

Anticipated completing their bachelor's degree in three years or less



More than 60% reported that they planned on pursuing a graduate or professional degree

Said "*academic reputation*" was the most influential factor in transferring to NC State



Two-in-five said they were taking fewer than 15 credit hours during their first semester at NC State



- 45% are from a rural area or small town
- 25% are first generation college students
- 67% feel their previous college/university prepared them well for NC State
- 18% mentioned being concerned about issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic in starting at NC State
