



OGC Organizational Chart






Records Requests by Fiscal Year

EthicsPoint: Total Reported Concerns by Fiscal Year







Use of Race in Admissions, Again?

Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v. President & Fellows of Harvard College Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v. University of North Carolina

Supreme Court Will Hear Challenge to Affirmative Action at Harvard and U.N.C.

The court's new conservative supermajority may be skeptical of admissions programs that take account of race to foster educational diversity.

Issues: (1) Whether the Supreme Court should overrule **Grutter v. Bollinger** and hold that institutions of higher education cannot use race as a factor in admissions; and (2) whether Harvard College is violating **Title VI** of the Civil Rights Act by penalizing Asian American applicants, engaging in racial balancing, overemphasizing race and rejecting workable race-neutral alternatives.
