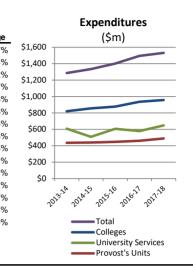

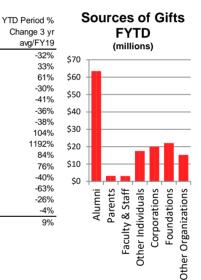

YEAR IN REVIEW

This year, the Libraries moved forward strategically on a number of fronts, expanding our capabilities to meet the university's growing needs and interests in areas such as data science and management; visualization; virtual and augmented reality; making, fabrication, and 3D printing; and research capacity and competitiveness. We are deeply engaged with campus partners in the planning and design for the renovation of the Hill Library, featuring the Academic Success Center (ASC), anticipating many new opportunities to enrich the student experience through collaborative and complementary services and technologies.

In the meantime, a variety of needed enhancements and updates to other library learning spaces were undertaken this year, aiming to alleviate the impact of the loss of valuable study seating during the construction phase of the renovation project (2019–20) and to produce an eventual, significant increase in high-demand group and quiet study seating.
