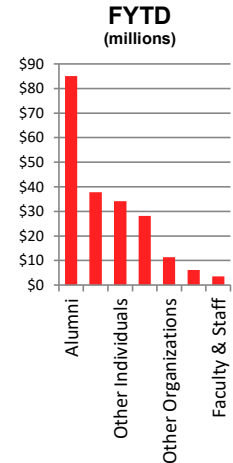
* Tuition and fee rates included on this schedule are based on rates approved by the Board of Governors in February 2024. The UNC System Office guidance memo on the FY 2024-25 tuition and fee adjustments, dated September 18, 2023, stipulated there would be no tuition increases for resident undergraduate students, and increases would be considered for nonresident undergraduate students, and graduate resident and nonresident students.
