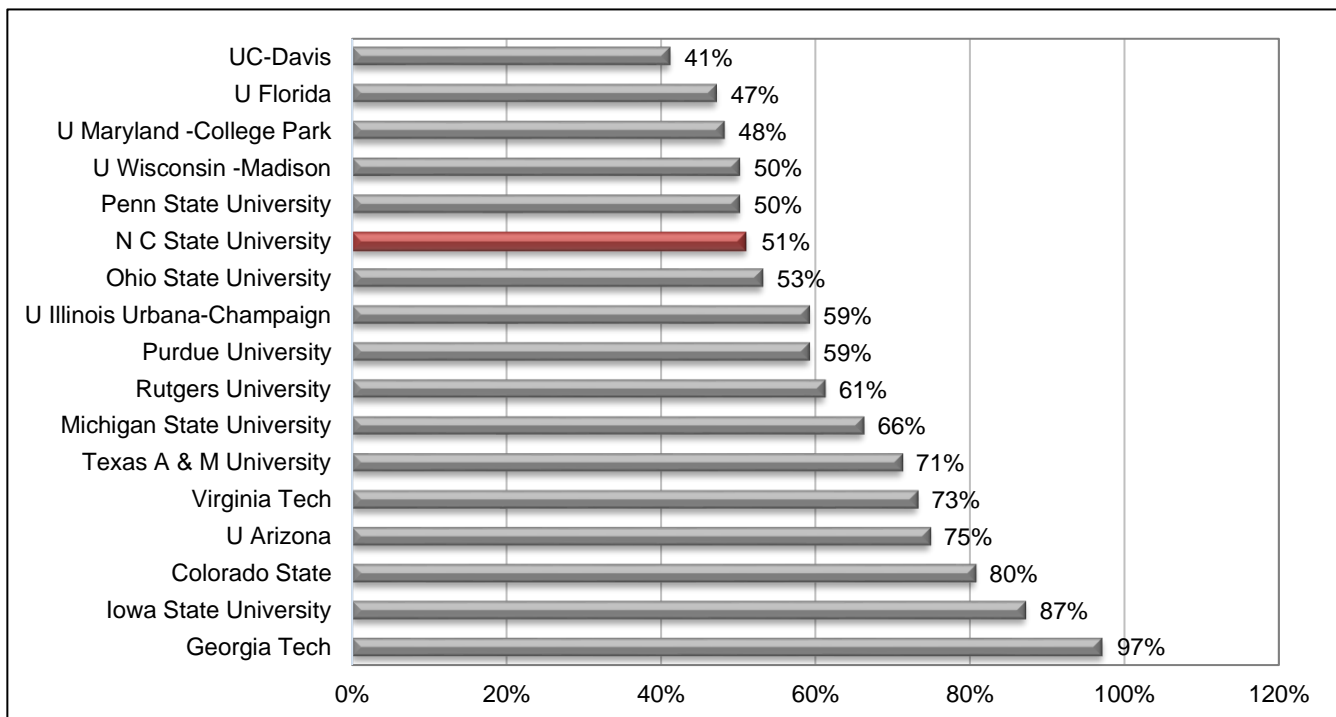

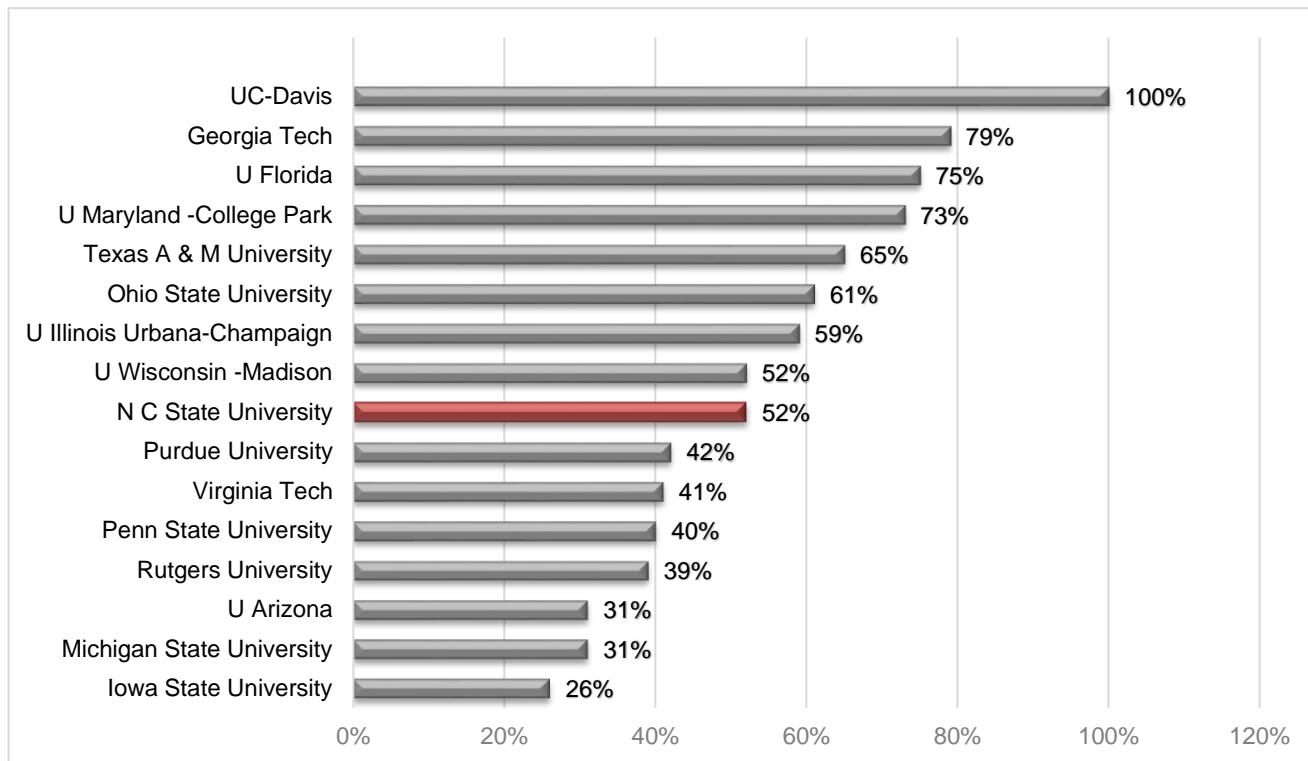
Fall 2014 - Student Acceptance Rate

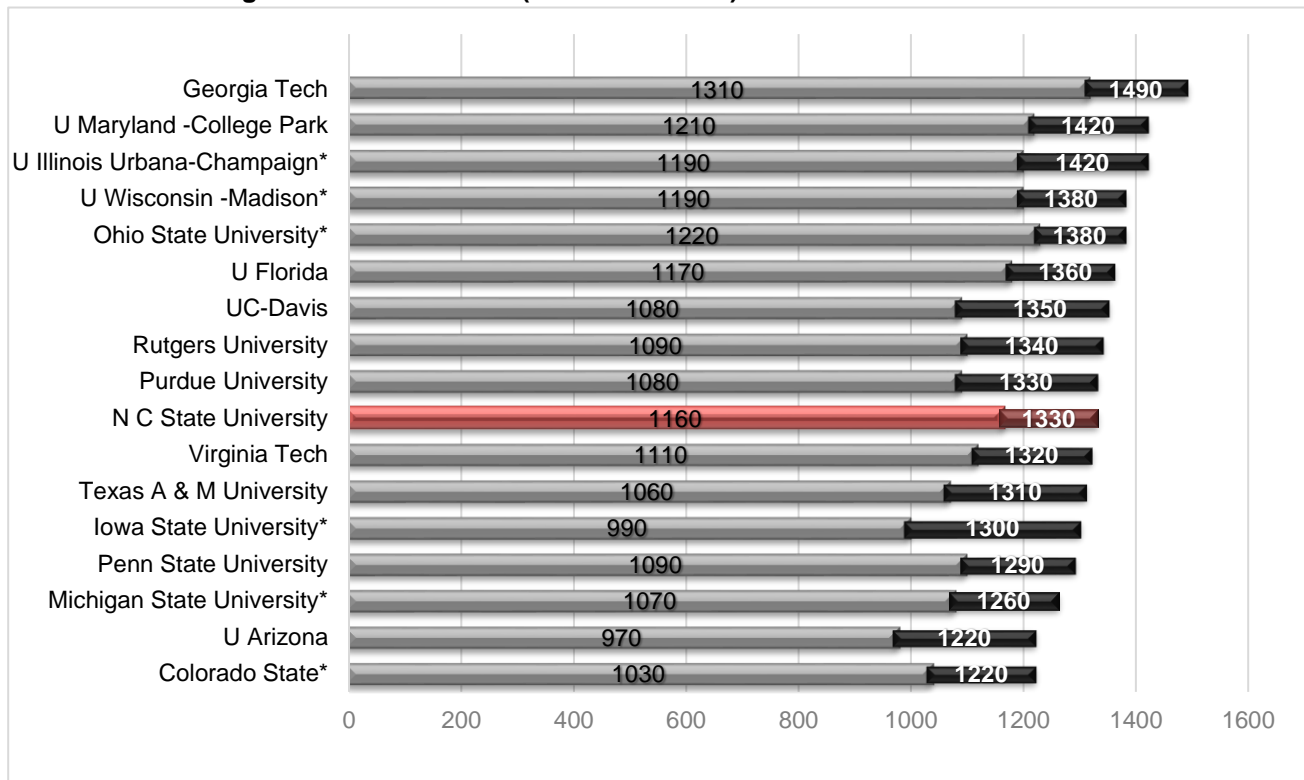
NC State University Peer Comparison of New Freshmen Admissions Measures
